History of the B.I.A

- Liability policy's were purchased to cover the B.I.A. for Fundraising Activities.
- ► This covered the Boosters members while participating in Fundraising Activities ONLY.
- ► It did not cover any Booster club members while participating in &/ or volunteering in any athletic activity.

Coverage Comparison Example #1

► Team A (Higher Exposure) BIA premium \$465 annual team fee plus \$918 for camps. Total:\$1,382.

Estimated if No BIA Coverage \$2,000 minimum.

► Savings \$618.

Coverage Comparison Example #2

► Team B (Lower Exposure) BIA premium \$232 annual team fee plus \$0 for camps Total:\$232.

Estimated if No BIA Coverage \$750 minimum.

► Savings \$518.

B.I.A. Coverage

Sport Leagues - Out of season.

B.I.A. Coverage for Students

- ▶ Fundraising activities for the boosters clubs that are part of the B.I.A.
- ▶ Booster club sponsored Winter/Summer Sport Camps & Clinics.
- ▶ Booster club sponsored Sport Leagues.
- ▶ Booster club sponsored Special Events / Tournaments.

B.I.A. Coverage for Coaches & Volunteers

- ▶ Fundraising activities for the boosters clubs that are part of the B.I.A.
- ▶ Working in concession stand & driving students during a bottle drive.
- ▶ Booster club sponsored Winter/Summer Sport Camps & Clinics.
- ▶ Booster club sponsored Sport Leagues.
- ▶ Booster club sponsored Special Events / Tournaments.

Booster Club Activities Covered Under the Current Policy

- Coaches & Volunteer coaches while they are participating in & /or running sports camps & / or leagues.
- Coverage for Booster club member who is transporting equipment, using equipment or facilities of others and property is damaged & someone sustains bodily injury by a booster member.
- Coverage for Sexual Abuse & Molestation.
- Coverage for any non-district student who is injured.
- Coverage for a District or Non District student or Booster member who causes bodily injury & or property damage to another person & or facility.
- Coverage for any non –district and district students if they are injured.

Policy Coverage

- Liability\$1,000,000 per incident/\$3,000,000 aggregate per incident.
- ► Sexual Abuse Molestation \$1,000,000 per incident/\$3,000,000 aggregate per incident.
- Non-Owned Hired Vehicles.
- ► Accident/Medical \$25,000.

Liability Policy for B.I.A.

- ▶ All Members of the Baldwinsville Interscholastic Association.
- ► All Volunteers.

- ► Coaches & Managers.
- ► All Participates.

What is Now Covered

- ▶ Participant & General Liability for the school district resident participants & non resident participants in Booster Club run camps/clinics & leagues.
- ▶ All coaches managers & volunteers are covered.
- ► Accident Medical Insurance for non resident participants & volunteers in booster run camps/clinics & leagues.
- Sexual Abuse & Molestation Coverage for all coaches, managers & volunteers.
- Non-Owned Hired Auto coverage in the event a vehicle is used to pick up & or transport items/people & an accident occurs. This will give additional coverage over the personal auto policy.

Cost for Upcoming Year 2024-2025

- Historically General Liability, Participant Liability, Sexual Abuse, Molestation, Non-Owned Hired Vehicles Additional Charges: \$120 per team & then a per person fee for camps & leagues.
- Camps & Leagues Fees Additional cost \$8 Per Camper & Per B'Ville League player.
- Important Note: If a camper participates in (2)two separate camps for example, lacrosse & volleyball, he or she would have to pay \$8 for both camps equaling \$16. If a camper is participating in (2)two camps for the same sport for example, basketball Camp weeks 1 & 2 he or she would only be charged the one time camp fee of \$8.
 - ***Non district participants cost \$12.
- Reviewing payment breakout process for the **2024-2025** year to create a lump sum annual payment per team based on the previous year's participates & events.
- ▶ It is mandatory for accurate rosters from camps & leagues to be kept by boosters/coaches and submitted to the athletic office in a timely fashion.

► As well as any other Booster member.

Facility Use Request ~ ML Schedules

- ▶ To get started & register for your requester account.
- When creating your requester account please be sure to use your GROUP NAME (i.e.: Boys Lacrosse Booster Club, Football Booster Club, BYSA, etc) & NOT just your first & last name.
- ▶ Please be sure to choose the correct GROUP CLASSIFICATION & upload your Certificate of Insurance and/or 501c(3) Status Letter when applicable. YOUR GROUP CAN NOT BE APPROVED AS A REQUESTER UNTIL THE APPLICABLE DOCUMENTATION IS UPLOADED.

Facility Use Request ~ ML Schedules Cont.

- NOTE 1: If request's are made for Booster purposes (open gyms, camps, etc.) just using your teacher name, they will be denied. You must use the established Booster Club Account.
- NOTE 2: If request's are made for travel teams or non-booster functions (other than open gyms, fundraising and camps etc.) using the teacher name or Booster Account, they will also be denied. Travel Teams & Leagues must also create a separate requester account with their name (i.e. Baldwinsville Sting, Swarm, United Soccer, Fusion etc.) and upload their own Certificate of Insurance & 501c3.
- ▶ DO NOT MAKE ANY TRAVEL TEAM, OUTSIDE GROUP OR LEAGUE REQUESTS UNDER YOUR BOOSTER CLUB ACCOUNT.
- ▶ Please attempt to make your request 2 weeks in advance.

Outside groups – clubs/leagues/youth.
